ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

5-7-13 through 5-20-13

Waste Water Treatment Plant

- Flows have been normal to above normal over the last three weeks.
- New processor has been installed and tested. The used unit was returned to Rawdon Meyers.
- The wear plate for the Vaughn pump on the septage receiving system had to be machined and was replaced with no problems.

Sanitary Sewer Collection System

• Cleaning of the problem in areas in town will be done over the next two weeks

Water System and Water Plant

- We continue to perform normal maintenance at the plant.
- We completed installation of the waterline on SR 42 and prepared the ground for seeding and strawing the week of 5-24.
- The new line has been pressure tested and samples have been taken for bacteria testing.
- The W Marion Rd water line replacement has been restored and seeded and strawed.
- Pavement repair should also begin the week of 5-20-13.
- The approach and curd is being replaced as part of the grant. This will be replaced from the center line east which is where the damage was done
- We have been replacing meters and curb boxes. (**Ongoing**)
- We are working on a way to place the S Main water line on the high district. It is currently on the low district tower (Douglas St). This will increase the pressure in the line and increase volume and flow.

Other issues

None at this time

Recreation / Pool

- The pool has been cleaned and is being filled. This will be complete by 5-17-13. The chemicals were received on 5-14-13 to begin the 2013 season.
- The recreation staff has been cleaning the pool house and preparing for the opening on Memorial weekend.

Street / Storm Sewer

- Cold patching of the streets is ongoing.
- American Pavements on schedule for slurry seal and crack sealing currently planned for this summer probably August.

Office

• Nothing new to report at this time.

Development

• The USEPA has mobilized to begin the cleanup at HPM Plant 2. A meeting will be held and updates from Steve Wolfe (USEPA) will be given online weekly.
