Donna Carver representing Protecting Our Water and Environmental Resources (Morrow County POWER) gave a brief presentation to the Fire and Police Committee. Ms. Carver has been researching medical and health related issues in Ohio since 1998. Ms. Carver has concern how of brine and waste are disposed from fracking and the right of the public to be informed when trucks transported waste and brine through our county.

In 2012, Gov. Kasich's Senate Bill 315 was introduced. This Senate Bill regulates framework for new technologies that allow rock formations. There are two bills at the present time in the statehouse: Senate Bill 17 and Senate Bill 42. Morrow County, POWER is seeking support from emergency workers and local communities.
